You Can Make a Bequest

You may find the following wordings to be helpful. These brief descriptions are not intended as legal or financial advice. Please consult your attorney or financial planner.



- To Make a Simple Bequest

"I give and bequeath to Project Bread - The Walk for Hunger, Inc., of 145 Border Street, East Boston, Massachusetts, 02128, the sum of \$ _____ (or a specific item of property, such as real estate, stocks or bonds, automobile, etc.) to be used as the organization determines."

- To Make a Residual Bequest

You may choose to leave the residue of your estate after you have provided for family and other beneficiaries. "I give and bequeath to Project Bread - The Walk for Hunger, Inc., of 145 Border Street, East Boston, Massachusetts, 02128, the residue of my estate, to be used as the organization determines."

- To Make a Percentage Bequest

"I give and bequeath to Project Bread - The Walk for Hunger, Inc., of 145 Border Street, East Boston, Massachusetts, 02128, _____% (name a specific percentage) of the total value of my estate to be used as the organization determines."
